#### **Presidents Message**

Here's some good news reported by our District 3 representatives Fran Leary and John Riopelle. District 3 has decided to name its spring regional in honor of Norma Shelly. One caveat, however, this honor will last only as long as the regional is held here in the capital district. Considering attendance at most regionals has been dwindling, attendance at the Saratoga regional has been holding its own. Who knows what the future holds, however, and the best way to counteract potentially lower attendance by out-of-town players is to better the already good turnout on the part of Unit 115 members.

In remembrance of Norma, the Board has opted to purchase a plaque for display at the registration desk of the spring regional. I may be somewhat biased, but I find our registration desk to be better than most, if not all, of the registration desks at regionals I've attended. We've been well and capably staffed, enhancing the experience of all players. I can't think of a better place to exhibit our perpetual thoughts of Norma. For those that may not have noticed, **please** take another look at the schedule for the Friday of the January Sectional. We've changed the times of the afternoon and evening games to 12:30 and 5:30, respectively. The earlier afternoon start will allow those people playing only in the afternoon session to drive home with as much daylight as possible. The much earlier evening start is in response to those who play in the afternoon and say they would stay for the evening session if not for the long stay between sessions. The obvious proof of the pudding is whether we get increased attendance on Friday evening. So, let's hold the debate, see what happens, and adjust accordingly times for the April and subsequent sectionals.

In the last Newsletter, I wrote about the potential for clubs to hold Unit-rated games. We have determined the unit can sponsor up to 24 such games a year, and will seek to schedule them beginning in 2013. Unit-rated games held simultaneously at more than one club count only as one of our 24 opportunities. We have notified club managers in the unit of the rules regarding scheduling, etc., and will work with them to obtain ACBL sanctioning for the unit-rated games they request. When possible, we'll list upcoming games in the Newsletter's schedule of upcoming events, but be sure to keep in touch with club managers and directors for complete information on any special games they may be holding.

Finally, we've initiated our annual fund-raiser featuring delicious pies from Smith's Orchard Bake Shop. Cost remains the same as previous years, \$10 for a 10 inch pie, \$15 for 3 five inch pies (orders for 5 inch pies must be for the same flavor). Enclosed is an order form which may be turned in to me or the fund-raising coordinators at your club games. Happy holidays, everyone.

We will be working hard to fulfill our mission and vision. I will report more to you on our plans after San Francisco.


