Presidents Message

As I write my last President's Report, I'm inclined to look back at the last three years to see what damage I may have inflicted on Unit 115, and can only hope not too much. If my hope is true, it would be because of the good people, mostly on the Board but others, also, who work hard to schedule and run our five sectionals and three unit games each year. I'm grateful for having been surrounded by such dedicated volunteers through my tenure as president.

In the past, I've suggested the Board could use new members, if only for some fresh ideas, and am pleased to announce Bill Kelsey and Dave Buchyn will be joining us. Additional volunteers would be welcome. We meet only five times per year, all between the Saturday sessions of our sectionals, so the time commitment for meetings is hardly onerous. Obviously, there's follow-up duties needed to run our eight events, but the work is not hard. Let us know if you're interested in joining.

In addition to a changed slate of officers who will be impaneled at the January, 2014 Board meeting, other changes include Bill Dubay

agreeing to be the Unit Historian, and I will be taking over as Tournament Coordinator.

It's the time of year for the start of our annual fund raiser, monies which will be used to offset the Unit's costs for hospitality at the June Norma Shelly Saratoga Regional, and that's why this edition of the Newsletter contains a form to order pies from Smith's Orchard Bake Shop. Cost for each pie is only \$10.00, a bargain in itself for these delicious pies, so consider ordering a pie or two. Not only that, your pie orders will be personally delivered to your favorite club game by Walter Smith.

Finally, here are two changes for next year. First, we will not field teams for the President's Cup on the basis of four different masterpoint levels for each team member. Instead, we will run the event similar to a Pro-Am. Come with a partner, we'll quartile the field based on the masterpoint totals of the partnerships, and randomly match pairs from the top and bottom and second and third quartiles. The difference between a traditional Pro-Am and the President's Cup is you will play only one of the four matches with your partner. You will partner with one of your teammates for the other three matches. The President's Cup will still be the Unit's fun event of the year, but we will avoid the difficulty of establishing, and then filling, all the teams with players meeting the four different masterpoint limits.

Second, the time for the Friday afternoon pairs game for the January sectional has been moved back to 12:30. This is in response to a number of players who expressed concern over driving home in the dark after the session. We will also change the start of the Friday afternoon session of the November sectional to 12:30.

THIS 'N THAT FROM YOUR DISTRICT DIRECTOR

As we begin another year, I look to continuing to work with all of you to make District 3 the shining star of the ACBL.

At the ACBL Board meetings in Phoenix in November we elected a new president, Phyllis Harlan from District 15, an Oklahoma City resident, who has been an active and productive member of the Board for a number of years. I have served on several committees with Phyllis and have a very high regard for her dedication and her competence.

We continue to be very pleased with the leadership of our new – since late 2011 – CEO, Robert Hartman. An interesting sidelight, Robert was so impressed with the success of The Longest Day in raising money for the Alzheimers Association, he ran in the Chicago marathon to raise even more money for the cause.

The board voted unanimously to extend the ban on smoking at national tournaments to cover electronic smoking devices. For now this ban only applies to national tournaments, but it is clearly an issue that should be addressed at the district and unit levels as well.

Five key initiatives were approved for 2014:

- Online learn to play bridge. This will be launched with a general marketing campaign and the results will be tracked.
- Win-Win membership incentives. This will replace the current system and will reward members for success in recruitment. It will be open to all members and teachers.
- 3. Membership recognition program.
 This will reward members based on

- both rank achievements and years of membership.
- OLLI (Osher Lifelong Learning Institute). Funded by the Bernard Osher Foundation, this program will help fund lifelong teaching programs.
- 5. Bridge at college. A program to encourage organized bridge programs at the college and university level.

Of interest to all of you is the change in membership dues. As of April 1, 2014, new member dues will increase from \$28 to \$29, and regular one year dues will increase from \$37 to \$39. There will be no increase in Junior or Patron memberships. In addition, tournament sanction fees will be increased by 1.5% beginning April 1, 2014.

The Board also overwhelmingly approved a new Youth Protection and Abuse Prevention Policy. We felt strongly that this was long overdue.

Our first Regional Tournament of the new year will be the Joan Gerard District 3 Winter Regional from January 14-20 at the Hilton Westchester in Rye Town, NY. We will be formally renaming this tournament in Joan's honor. We hope many of you can join us for a celebration on Sunday evening following the team game. Make your plans to attend this wonderful tournament.

I look forward to seeing you all at the tables.
