Tournament Director's Message

For one of the few times since the '70's, perhaps only the second, a sectional tournament sponsored by Unit 115 was not held at the Studio of Bridge and Games in Schenectady. Instead, the November sectional took place at the Albany Jewish Community Center.

We'd like to report the change in venue went off without a hitch, but those who played in the first session Friday afternoon experienced a delay in start time. The delay was unavoidable, as the Director-in-Charge, who was at the facility at 9:00 for a 12:00 game time, was not allowed into the playing area until 11:30. It became impossible to carry in and set up the computer, bring in nearly a dozen briefcases filled with pre-dealt hands and director materials, place guide cards on the tables, sell entries, and start the game on time. With the closing of the Studio of Bridge and Games, we will be hosting sectionals in rented space at "third-party" locations for the foreseeable future, and will be confirming with the owners what times we have full access to the playing area before leasing the space.

Thereafter, everything went smoothly and we're pleased to report the tournament, itself, was a success. We had over 100 tables in play, a big improvement over the attendance at our sectional held November of 2013. However, attendance

for the 0-300 games continues to be disappointing. Despite offering two entries for ten dollars, nearly half price, to play in the 0-300 pairs game or in a higher rated pairs game when playing with a partner also having fewer than 300 master points, we sold only ten dual entries over the entire weekend. This led to an insufficient number of tables for the 0-300 game Friday afternoon, which required combining it with the open game.

We're trying to encourage more 0-300 players to attend our sectionals. When a dual entry is purchased and fully used, the per session price is surely right, cheaper than any club game and less expensive than a 120-minute movie at the theater. You get to play against your peers, get hand records for the session, and have access to more experienced players who would be glad to answer questions and provide guidance when asked. So, if you're under 300 master points, consider playing in upcoming sectionals. Our ability to schedule separate 0-300 sections in the future depends on attendance, so let's get the attendance up to assure their continuation.

To help everyone plan ahead, here are the remaining 2015 schedules for both the sectionals hosted by the Unit and Regionals hosted by District 3:

The Unit also schedules three charity games each year. In 2015, two will be held at the new Shelley Studio, the President's Cup team game on August 22 and Christmas Party open pairs game on December 13. The third charity event, Awards Dinner followed by an open pairs game, will be held May 16 at a site not yet determined.

Each year, District 3 schedules several sectional tournaments at clubs, better known as "STACs." These sectionally rated silver point games are played at regularly scheduled club games. Participating players not only receive silver points based on their percentage game at their own club, but can receive a higher number of silver points for coming in overall because scores are compared with pairs in other clubs playing the same pre-dealt hands at the same time. STACs scheduled by District 3 in 2015 are March 24-30, June 15-21, and October 19-25.

Finally, the Unit, upon request of club managers, will also schedule "Unit-Rated" Games and Club Championships. These games, held at regularly scheduled club venues, offer sectional-level master point rewards. The first two such games for 2015 are scheduled to be held at the Avila Duplicate Bridge Club on Thursday evening February 19 and Saturday afternoon February 28. Please consider playing in these games as well as all other weekly games in the Unit's local clubs.

THIS 'N THAT FROM YOUR DISTRICT DIRECTOR

As we begin a new year I want to wish all of you happiness and good health as well as success at the bridge table. We are about to begin the first of our Regionals for the year in Rye Brook, NY in mid January. You will see from the Rye Brook schedule that we will have a two session gold point event on the first day. That is a result of a decision made by the ACBL board in Providence in November. You will see that explanation below as well, along with information on a number of other important decisions that will affect all of us at the Unit and District levels beginning in early 2015.

All Regionals are now allowed to be 7 full days instead of 6 ½. This means we can have a two session gold point event beginning at 1 pm on the first day of the tournament. These events will be charity events. We will start this in Rye Brook in January. Since the first day of our recent

Regionals have been poorly attended, we hope the opportunity to hold an exciting two session game that day will provide a real boost to our attendance.

A number of other problems were also addressed. Craig Robinson, Director of our neighbor, District 4, did an excellent job of summarizing the problems and solutions in his recent District Director's Report, so I am going to unashamedly plagiarize from his write up:

- ➤ **Problem #1** A 20 table pair game awards the same masterpoints for winning as a 20 table team game. To win the pairs game, you must beat 39 other pairs, but in the team game, you must only beat 19 teams. The solution . Increase overall awards in pair games at the Sectional and Regional levels by 25%. To partially curb this highly inflationary change, there will be a) a reduction in overall awards from 35% to 25% of the field, and b) a decrease in the awards by 20% in all games with an upper limit on masterpoints. The impact of these changes will keep the awards in limited pair games, (e.g. Gold Rush) where they are, and will somewhat
- Problem #2 There is a need to recognize that Sectional games run by an ACBL director are generally more professional than are club games run by club directors.
 The solution. Increase overall awards in Sectional games by 10%

lower team game awards.

awards in Sectional games by 10% and decrease STAC awards by 10%. Since almost all STACs are pairs games, when you also account for the 25% increase for pair games, STAC awards will actually increase somewhat.

Problem #3. A ten table A/X game on top of a 40 table Gold Rush game receives 50% more masterpoints than the same ten table A/X game running on top of a 20 table B/C/D event. This is a major inequity since the Gold Rush fields are typically much larger than B/C/D fields.

The Solution. The first part of the solution here was to no longer count subordinate tables when computing the awards for the A/X field. The second part of the solution was to create a formula to base the A/X awards solely on the size of the A/X field. The formula will be close to masterpoint neutral – i.e. no inflation – unless the popularity of the A/X events increases, in which case the awards will increase.

Another change in Regionals will be the addition of games which will appeal to members who have too many masterpoints to play in Gold Rush Pairs but who are not comfortable in the current open pairs above that event. Beginning in January 2015 there will be games available with three stratifications – open/3000/1500. We hope that more people will now be able to find exactly what they are looking for.

As you can see from the above, there is much going on at the National level. If you are interested in further background on the changes, I encourage you to go to the ACBL web page and then to the minutes of the Providence Board meetings. There were many changes and I would be happy to discuss any of them with you. Please feel free to contact me with any questions, suggestions, etc.
